Minutes of ANMF Board Meeting on 5/17/2020

Election of new president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer

Board thanked outgoing president and the executive team for their service.

Board accepted the resignation of the outgoing president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and project committee co-chairs.

To fill the vacant positions, board nominated the following candidates:

- Dr. Bhupesh Khadka-for the President of ANMF
- Dr. Binod Khadka -for the vice president of ANMF
- Dr. Bishnu Sapkota-for the Secretary of ANMF
- Ms. Kalpana Shrestha-for the Treasurer of ANMF

Board action: Board unanimously elected above candidates.

Election of new board members

Board approved to expand current board members from nineteen to twenty-two.

Board elected Dr Raju Bishwakarma Century, Dr. Dixa Dhital and Dr. Sandesh Pandit for the board of directors.

Election of project committee chair

Board elected Dr. Santosh Sapkota for the chair of the project committee.

Election of a new member to finance committee

Board elected Dr. Sandesh Pandit to serve as a member in the finance team.

Projects Committee Updates

The president summarized our current work, collaboration of ANMF with many other partners to fight the potential COVID-19 pandemic impact in Nepal. ANMF has sent \$100,000 to ANMF Nepal to help procure and distribute essential PPE to various hospitals in Nepal, to help facilitate diagnostic capability of COVID-19 including rent of sample collecting vehicle, to set up tele health capability at Institute of Medicine, Kathmandu. President mentioned that, in collaboration with other partners in Nepal, ANMF has been able to help formulate guidelines regarding PPE use, testing, treatment for COVID-19 in Nepal. More than 15 webinars regarding COVID related issues were already done for healthcare providers and patients of Nepal and many more will be done in near future. The details of these works are available in the project map.

The board decided to close the web portal for new project applications due to current financial status until further notice.

The board was notified of a pending review of two new projects that have been submitted to ANMF. Due to current financial status, we have not reviewed the projects. A letter will be sent to the organizations of the delay.

Financial Update

Treasurer updated on the current financial status of ANMF. Finance team updated the board that we have about a \$13,732 shortfall in reserves after projects on hold are funded.
