Upcoming change in board and officers

- Motion is made to increase the size of the board to 25. Bylaws allow board numbers to be upto 30 as deemed necessary by the board. Motion is appropriately seconded and unanimously approved.
- The board received intentions from two board members to step down from upcoming AGM- Dr. Chandra Chataut and Dr. Santosh Sapkota.
- Of the eight candidates, seven candidates meet the criteria set forth by the ANMF board on March 25, 2018 to be board members. These candidates are Bikash Bhattarai, Navin Kaini, Saroj Kandel, Shradha Manandhar, Narayan Neupane, Vikash Pathak, Swikrity Upadhaya.
- The four current board members' positions are going to expire at the time of AGM and they all have expressed intention to continue to serve. These directors are Bhupesh Khadka, Bishnu Sapkota, Dinesh Subedi and Anil Suwal.

- There are 11 candidates for 11 total open slots. General members will be asked to elect these candidates in the AGM.
- Expected changes in officers- Binod Khadka for President, Bishnu Sapkota for Vice President, Jivan Lamichhane for secretary and Kalpana Shrestha for Treasurer. The new board members will elect these officers during AGM in the presence of all members.
- Disclaimer Jivan and Shraddha wil be two board members who are also spouses.

D.Project Updates-Oxygen plants 21ANMF005/21ANMF006/21ANMF007

Paperwork was done for sea transportation. Medioxy has sent funds to Novair but is facing some hurdles in sending dollars from Nepal to France. After receiving the fund, it will start repackaging the plants, and the shipping date will be confirmed. Board will get an update regarding the transportation cost if the amount exceeds USD 30,000. Funds left in ANMF Nepal may be able to cover nominal expenses if the cost of transportation changes.

E. AGM Preparation- going on full swing. Several FB live programs lined up. AGM preparation team meeting in between to finalize the agenda.

E.ANMF/USA President's recent visit to Nepal

President Bhupesh Khadka recently visited Nepal and firsthand observed and monitored some of the ANMF projects. He visited Amppipal Hospital and observed the oxygen plant along with the equipment donated like refill cylinders, battery backup system etc. The refill system that ANMF has supported is being used to fill and supply oxygen to the 5 ambulances around the catchment area of the hospital.

He visited the newly built Simulation lab that has been set up at Bir Hospital. The mankins have already been used to train health professionals. ANMF will be helping to build a debriefing room and set up an audio visual system for the lab.

The visit to Tarkang Community Center was limited due to inability to enter the center except for the outside premises. The patient examination rooms and other equipment could not be observed. Furthermore, the point of contact of this facility was standing for election in Nepal and dragged the ANMF President to the contact's political campaign. This was something that could be avoided by careful planning. Also he discussed the importance of avoiding any suggestion, even remotely, of any conflict of interest to maintain the apolitical reputation of the organization.

Bhupesh also participated in the Annual General Meeting of ANMF Nepal that was held on May 1, 2022 . ANMF Nepal formed a new body and the

The Board had a vibrant discussion about the fiduciary duties of the Board Members as mentioned above. These are guidelines for the Board Members to refer to.

Per Santosh- "Sorry I had to leave early. I wanted to stay up more to talk about "apolitical" agenda item. If ANMF is trying to police it's members we will start creating dictatorship organization. Please take this agenda to AGM and decide what directors or members can do and can't do so it's in bylaws! To me, supporting a candidate in any democratic election is a right of everyone. If we are not going to continue to respect that individual right, it's going to be difficult to get engaged with the organization. Please make sure this is part of the meeting minutes."

Above statement was addressed by other Board Members and the President of ANMF. Bhupesh said, "This is not about restraining individual freedom. We all respect individual freedom and their individual political beliefs. At the same time, the Board has fiduciary responsibilities towards the organization and the Directors have to be cognizant of their actions.

The Board recognized all of these duties and responsibilities while fully maintaining all the individual rights of a person.
