|                              | -Please see separate attachments for details on finance updates -2017 IRS tax return has been filed  Summary: Remaining funds- Total 306,531 USD of which Earthquake account has199,371 and general account has 103,964 USD. Out of the EQ fund, 127.4 k has been committed to various projects already approved and FA letters have been sent to the respective organizations. Another 21.9k has been set aside for potential funding of SIMS center. This leaves EQ account balance down to 56k.  -The Board has decided to continue holding solicitation of new projects until the Annual General Meeting in Phoenix on 5/2018 |

#### I. Updates of the projects approved as of 8/13/17

- 17TUTH001 Liver transplant Observership: Total: \$8000. The Board voted that the Project has been completed and is closed.
- 2. 17TCHC001 Tarkang Com Hlth Ctr (Project Manager : Santosh Sapkota): Fund received email sent March 2, 2018.
- 3. 17PHO001 Possible Charikot Hospital Expansion: \$14,500 transferred from US 10/17/2017. Richard Katzman, Project Manager for this project updated that he is is still awaiting response/report from Possible.
- 4. 17NAR001 Narchyang Health Post: Fund of \$31,052 has been transferred (confirmation of receipt of the fund received on 1/9/18) and construction of the community center started on 2/28/18 with hopes to complete before monsoon. Project Manager: Julia Shepardson.
- 5.17 NAMS001 joint telemedicine/ teleconference/ consultation: This Project has been handled by ERC (Education and Research Committee) . Project has been approved for \$11,750, though initially ask was from 13-18.2K. Fund assurance letter has been sent. Fund will only be transferred after confirmation of adequate functioning of the project. Project Managers: Prakash Neupane/ Santosh Sapkota

Dr Sangita Basnet, updated about this project as she was able to visit Bir hospital during her Nepal visit. Bir Hospital has bought LCD monitor and furniture for about 4k USD. She said that 9 licenses were bought which will be used to connect computers at different sites in Nepal with Bir hospital along with folks from US. This fund from ANMF will also cover for maintenance cost for this project for one year after which NAMS will bear the cost. Social welfare council approval is still pending.



#### Updates of the projects approved as of 8/13/17 contd

6. Awards for best oral/poster presentation for resident and fellow at SIMONS/ Society of Surgeons of Nepal/ NEPAS for Up to \$2000. Funds have not been sent; awaiting identification of best abstracts from SIMON/NEPAS from 2018 conference.

#### II. Update on Previous ANMF Nepal projects

- 1. ANMF/Nepal-Public Health- Sipapokhare: Funds transferred from US \$11,500. Update from Nepal: A.Toilets have been constructed at Chandrawati and Om Ram primary school- report has been received. B. Need report of 80 Toilets constructed at Archale Tole re Zinc plates, cement. C. ANMF-Nepal is waiting for reports from Sindhu Utthan Kendra (SUK; Mr.Basu Dev Adhikari) on the construction of water supply system at Om Ram primary school as well as repair and maintenance of old pipes and taps at Sipapokhare.
- 2. ANMF/Nepal-Project Oversight for 2017 (15K). The Board voted that the Project has been completed and is closed.
- 3. ANMF Nepal -Project oversight for 2018. Requested for 15 K USD on 2/8/18. The Board asked to clarify rent situation with ANMF Nepal as the office space was shared with NCCDF. Also ANMF Nepal has been requested to provide with important photos and videos of work done this year in Nepal so that it can be used for more fund raisers in the US. The Board decided do disburse amount in two equal installments after clarifying above questions and pending deliverables furnished from ANMF Nepal. Dr Sangita Basnet will be following on these questions.



#### **Update on Previous ANMF Nepal projects contd**

- 4. Chautara District Hospital Prefab Emergency, male and female Ward (88K): Construction started by FIXIT engineering (Er Pashupati Shah) on 11/4/17 and almost complete. Formal handover from Government of Nepal has not happened yet. One room has been in use already. The Board asked that ANMF Nepal do a press release and work on coverage in different media on the handover ceremony. A separate report of the work done at this facility has been circulated by ANMF President, Sangita Basnet after her visit.
- 5. ANMF Health Posts (12 constructed): Total 519.5K USD. a.ANMF-Nepal has received the handover letter as well as the letter of gratitude from district health office, Sindhupalchowk. b.ANMF Nepal has instructed Fix it Engineering Pvt. Ltd to collect letter from each of the health posts confirming completion of all outstanding issues.
- 6. Chauthe Community Health Center, Nuwakot—> USD 44.6k has been set aside. Fund Assurance letter from ANMF has been sent. Social Welfare Council (SWC) has been asking for several documents and ANMF Nepal has been following up on it. Project Manager from US: Dr Sanjaya Khanal.
- 7. NCCDF-Manikins for Nurse Training-Fund transferred from US: \$5800. details of the training and confirmation of manikins were discussed in the meeting. The Board voted that the Project has been completed and is closed.
- 8.Health and Development Society Nepal (HDSN)- Temporary Health Shelters: HDSN submitted its report of completion of the remaining two health posts. The Board voted that the Project has been completed and is closed.
- 8. TUTH-Oxygen Concentration Plant: Awaiting report from ANMF Nepal. Based on previous updates, the project should be heading towards completion.

#### Update on Projects Approved/Disscussed on 12/3/17 Board Meeting

- 1. 17KUMS001 Physical Rehab At Dhulikhel Hospital: Fund requested 60.6K. Project manager: Ganesh Chaudhary. Fund Assurance (FA) letter sent on 2/6/18.SWC approval pending. Dhulikhel Rotary club sent a letter stating its intent to match some amount of the cost not specified at present.
- 2.17HFN001Psychiatric Rehab At Dang for 121922. Project managers: Binod Dhungana and Julia Shepardson. Fund approved \$30K[construction cost (\$25,000) and \$5k for educational/ training purpose]. Municipality will fund about NRs 5 lakhs. Construction for this project has already started. FA letter sent and SWC approval is pending.
- 3. 17IRHD001Training Girls For Mchb17 for 4.8K. Project Manager: Baroon rai. Based on recommendation and vetting done at the Projects committee The Board decided to approve this fund to IRHDTC Nepal to conduct this project. This fund will come out of the general fund.
- 4. 17SOAR001Nepal Ambulance Service for 5K. Projector Manager: Sunil Sharma. The Board approved the project via web ballot on 12/16/2017. FA letter sent 12/31/17. MOU between Nepal Ambulance Service (NAS) and ANMF signed on 3/21/18. SWC approval pending. Emergency Medical training completed at Butwal and Siddharthanagar.
- 5.17NCCDF001 Critical Care Simulation Center for 21.9K. Projector manager: Richard Katzman. The Board has decided to set aside this fund but hold voting on it until several outstanding issues are addressed. A web ballot will be conducted as soon as more information is obtained. Among other things, The Board was concerned about the name of the center, number of manikins needed and its costs, relation between ANMF and NCCDF with rent situation and possible concerns for conflict of interest and maintenance costs for 10 years as mentioned on the proposal.
